



## DOCUMENTS YOU MUST BRING TO APPLY FOR A CITY RESIDENCY DOCUMENT

**You must bring the following documents (original and photocopy) to your interview:**

- Original passport
- Certification from other towns and cities you have lived in in the last year (except the city of Barcelona)

**You may bring the following documents (original and photocopy) to your individual interview, if you have them:**

- Registration certificate/Foreign National ID Number (NIE - expired)
- Housing rental contract
- Birth certificate/marriage certificate/civil partnership certificate/notarial deed
- Foreign National ID Number (NIE)/National Identity Document/passport of your spouse or partner, child(ren), mother, father, sibling(s), niece(s), nephew(s), grandchild(ren) and/or grandparent(s)
- Family book
- Certificate of participation in courses, workshops, modules (social, professional, linguistic or cultural)
- Copy of immigration procedures filed
- Health card
- Library card
- Certificate of having received care at public or private services
- Child(ren)'s school certificate/registration
- Reception session attendance certificate
- Certificate/registration for academic studies taken (or under way)
- Certificate/membership card for a public/private/non-governmental organisation or entity
- Certificate of participation in Catalan or Spanish courses
- Membership card of an entity
- Employment history: contracts, pay slips, bank statement or other means of supporting yourself, etc.
- Other documents you consider relevant to link you to the city of Barcelona.
